Grandstand hold a zero tolerance policy for drugs and alcohol in order to maintain a safe and professional environment for all employees, clients and subcontractors.

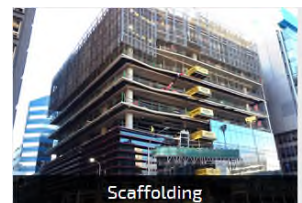
Part of your duty of care is to ensure you present fit for work in an appropriate physical, mental and emotional state that will not impact on safety.
